

Eye (Cataract surgery) Camp

With wonderful support from the Japanese philanthropic eye surgical team known as Association for Ophthalmic Cooperation in Asia (AOCA), Delek, in collaboration with the Rotary Club Dharamsala, successfully organised



its 14th consecutive annual Eye Camp at the Delek Hospital. The camp was held over four days starting from the 27th-30th December 2013.

Dr. D. S. Gurung, Chief Medical Officer, Zonal Hospital at Dharamsala kindly spared his time to be the Chief Guest and inaugurated the camp.

It was a coincidence that the District Governor of the Rotary Club 3070, Rtn. Dr. Pawan Gupta happened to be in Dharamsala for a Rotary meeting at the same time and kindly accepted our

invitation to be the Guest of Honour. The surgical team from Japan consisted of five surgeons, one nurse and two coordinators.

Every year hundreds of patients arrive here to avail themselves of this service, but due to time con-



straint we screen each patient carefully and select the patients whose cataracts are ready to be operated upon. Out of total of 250 patients, 66 underwent surgery. Of those undergoing surgery, 45 were local Indians and the remaining were Tibetans.

As usual the patients were all admitted overnight to Delek Hospital following their cataract surgery and provided with free board and lodging.
